Tariff for the reproduction of TV productions

Pursuant to section 13 of the German Copyright Administration Act by way of deviation of the tariff dated 18th April 1996, published in the German Federal Gazette no. 111 dated 17th June 1995, page 6535, GVL, Heimhuder Straße 5, D-20148 Hamburg, herewith publishes the following Tariff for the reproduction of TV productions

- 1. For a one-off reproduction of TV productions for business uses or by enterprises for internal purposes, EUR 50.00 shall be payable for each partial or whole minute of GVL protected repertoire played.
- For a one-off reproduction of TV productions for educational and training purposes or by non-profit institutions for non-commercial purposes, EUR 40.00 shall be payable for each partial or whole minute of the GVL protected repertoire played.
- 3. The licence fee for any further reproduction in line with item 1 shall amount to 10% of the licence fee for one-off reproductions; provided that permission needs to be obtained from GVL prior to any further reproductions.
- 4. Licence fees for any further reproduction in line with item 2 shall be 5% of the licence fee for one-off reproductions, provided that no more than 100 copies are made, otherwise it shall be 1% of the licence fee or one-off reproductions; again, provided that permission needs to be obtained from GVL prior to any further reproductions.
- 5. The licence fees thus calculated shall be increased by the respective value-added tax in force.
